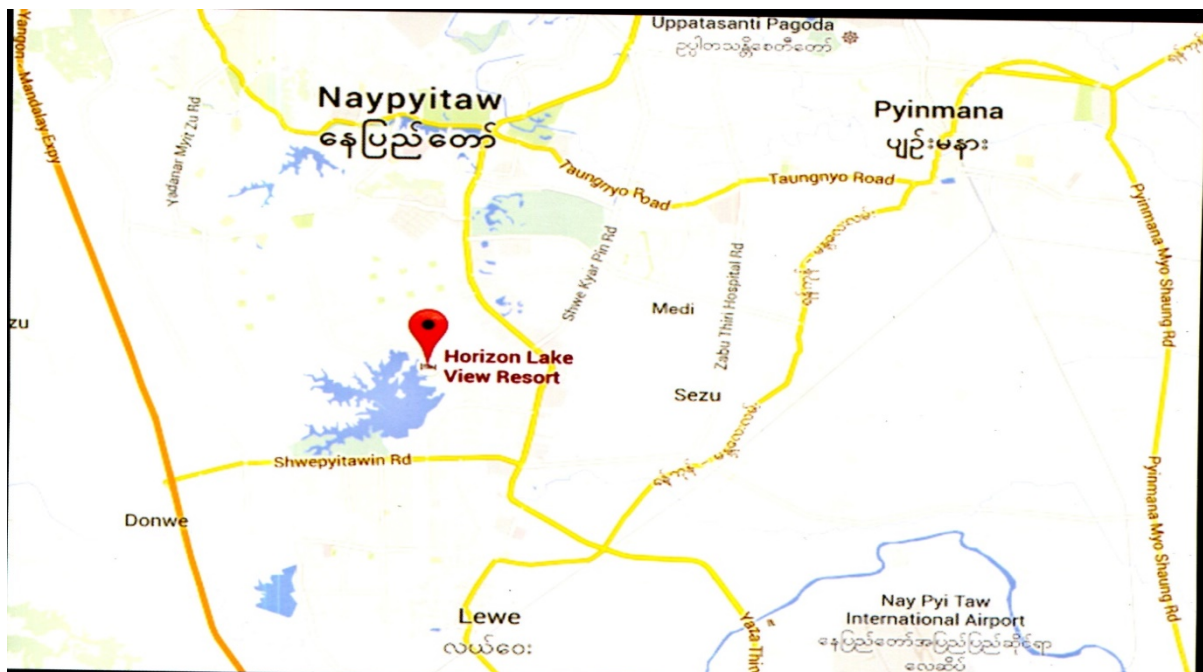


A. Introduction

B. Meeting Venue

C. Airport Transfer

Country delegates will be provided airport-hotel transportation service. Liaison officers will accompany delegates to vehicles assigned to bring them to and from designated hotels.

- ❖ **Local Time:** Myanmar is 6:30 hours ahead of the Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+6:30).
- ❖ **Weather:** November is undoubtedly a great time to visit Bagan, with pleasant temperatures and nice weather. It's warm during the day and cool at night, with average day-time and night-time temperatures of 33°C (91°F) and 23°C (73°F).
- ❖ **Power Supply:** Power plugs and sockets are of type C, D, F and G in Myanmar. (Check out the following pictures.) You may need power plug adapter for these sockets type while your stay in Myanmar.



- ❖ **Money Changer:** Money Changers are available at the airport and near shopping centers.
- ❖ **Shopping:** The following shopping centers in Naypyitaw are opened daily from 9 am to 9 pm for shopping, foods and other utilities that you may need. Taxi Services are available at hotels. It takes about 5 minutes to Junction Centre/ Capital Hypermarket and about 30 minutes to Ocean Supercenter.
